Through our waters, we are connected to the Wadden Sea, northern Germany, but also to neighboring provinces of Friesland and Overijssel. In addition to canals, "maren" and rivers, Groningen also has several lakes. Enjoy the peace and beauty of the environment or dive into the liveliness of the city of Groningen. If you are in Drenthe, it is definitely worth visiting Meppel, Hoogeveen, Emmen or Assen. This can be nicely combined with the nature of the Drentsche Aa National Park or Drents-Friese Wouden National Park.

From the water you will experience the beautiful landscape just a little differently. Take, for example, the Reitdiep, one of the oldest waterways in the Netherlands. From Groningen you will sail past picturesque villages such as Garnwerd and Zoutkamp. Via the Lauwersmeer National Park you will sail via the Robbengat lock to the vast Wadden Sea area. The peace and space on the water in Groningen and Drenthe have a relaxing effect.

Bridges and locks, we have those too. Sometimes you sail right past it or underneath, but they are also served. On site by the bridge or lock keeper, remotely or via self-service. To ensure smooth and safe sailing, we have listed the operating times and other useful information.

You can discover Groningen and Drenthe from the water from at least from 1 May to 1 October. This brochure helps with good travel preparation and is useful to grab while sailing.

# Map of sailing routes in Groningen and Drenthe


The chart on the next page is not a navigation chart but refers to the waterways and self-service key distribution points described in this publication.

# Self-service bridges and locks

You can operate several bridges and locks in the province of Groningen yourself.

# Self-service key

In most cases, a 'self-service key' is required (sometimes the operation is done with a push button or pull cord). The same key can be used for different sailing circuits throughout the province. You only need to purchase one key. The deposit for a key is 35 euros.

The brochure indicates which bridges and locks are subject to self-service and where the key can be picked up and returned. We indicate the self-service with (Z). The blue numbers on the map indicate the approximate location.

# **Self-service instruction**

- Read the instructions on the panel near the bridge carefully. Self-service is not the same everywhere.
- Carry out the self-service step-by-step and not too quickly.
- In the case of self-service locks: do not enter until the signals indicate this. This prevents malfunctions.
- In the event of a malfunction, you can report it to the malfunction number at the bridge or lock.

# Be well prepared for your trip

Before departure, check whether a self-service key is required on the sailing route. Purchase the key on time.

# New bridge near Meerstad

The bridge near Meerstad is an exception. See Slochterdiep at waterway number 17.1 on page 18.

# Vertical clearance (H)

Clearance heights are indicated at Canal Level (KP), unless otherwise stated. If a summer and winter level applies, it is stated in relation to the summer level. We want to state the exact vertical clearances (H) without a safety margin (shock height).

The responsibility for passing a bridge or lock safely lies with the skipper. The vertical clearance (H) can deviate due to water level differences, weather influences, subsidence or typing errors.

In the province of Drenthe, the same operating times of bridges and locks apply on all waterways, with the exception of the Meppelerdiep and Meppel. Many bridges in Drenthe are operated in combination by the same bridge operator. It is possible that the bridge operator has not yet reached its destination when you arrive. Bridge keepers are in contact with each other and pass it on when a ship arrives. They know you're coming.

On some routes, the bridges are operated remotely. A request for a bridge opening can be requested via the report button at the bridge or lock, or via the indicated VHF channel. When entering the locks, take into account the end time of the operation.

# 32. Assen

For your information:

- H 54 dm. for shipping from the Noord-Willemskanaal via the Havenkanaal to Assen.
- H 35 dm. for shipping from the Drentsche Hoofdvaart to the center of Assen.

The Veenlust Bridge and the Witter Bridge in **the Vaart**, the 6 bridges and the 2 locks in the **'Blauwe As' waterway connection**, will be operated in Guided sailing. In the **Havenkanaal**, the Enkeerpad bicycle bridge (**BB H23**) and the Loonerbrug (**BB H24**) are operated remotely from the Peelo lock control station (VHF 18 / report button).

Are you coming from the Drentsche Hoofdvaart? Then a bridge operator will register you with the port authority of the municipality of Assen.

\*) For 'Het Kanaal' there are adjusted opening hours:

- After 16:00, ships from the direction of Groningen can no longer enter 'Het Kanaal' via the Blauwe Klap.

# 36. Verlengde Hoogeveensche Vaart (B) (A) (H 52 dm)

The bridges and locks are operated locally (in combination) by bridge and lock keepers in the Noordscheschut to Nieuw-Amsterdam route. Because the bridge keepers are in contact by telephone, the next bridge operator already knows about your arrival. After Nieuw-Amsterdam, bridges (VHF 22) and lock (VHF 20) will be operated remotely from the Westerveenschebrug to the Oosterveenschebrug.

#### Railway bridge Veenoord / Nieuw Amsterdam (A)

The railway bridge will be operated remotely by Prorail and opened for recreational shipping if possible according to the timetable, tel. 088 - 231 5006.

# 37. Veenvaart (H 35 dm)

There are 5 locks and 12 movable bridges in the sailing route. The Oranjesluis in the Bladderswijk (see there) is operated remotely. Request locks via the report button at the lock, on (VHF 20) or via tel. 0591 - 312 360.

The period of bridge operation in Ter Apel is only in the sailing season from May to September. Outside the sailing season, sailing to Ter Apel or to the Haren-Rütenbrock Canal (see route 1) is not possible.

# 38. Stieltjeskanaal (H 54 dm)

Stieltjeskanaalsluis, Drieklapsbrug, Westerveenschebrug, Ericasluis, Ericabrug, Oosterveenschebrug and Oranjesluis are operated from the Stieltjeskanaalsluis station, tel. 0592 - 365 775, report button or VHF (VHF 78). A maximum speed of 9 km/h applies in the Stieltjeskanaal.

# 39. Coevorden and Coevordersluis + Bridge (B)

#### For your information:

- From the Stieltjeskanaal: registered ships (via tel. 06 53 14 89 72) do not have to call the following bridges for an opening. The bridge keepers already know that you are coming. You can also call this number if you come from the marina.
- From the Coevorden-Vecht Canal: contact the bridge operator of the Monier Bridge on tel. 06 1281 4990. Then it is accompanied sailing again. If there is no answer, tel. 0524 513 823. The new railway bridge (towards Gramsbergen) is usually open except when a train arrives. tel. 088 231 5006.

# General (sailing) information

# Bridge and Lock: pass safely and smoothly

Anyone sailing through the Netherlands will come across many bridges and locks. This is no different in the provinces of Groningen and Drenthe. This can be done smoothly and safely by taking into account the rules and tips below.

# What to do at bridges?

- Don 't float around in front of the bridge.
- Moored at the waiting area.
- Avoid annoying waves.
- Join the rear of waiting ships and wait your turn.
- Follow the instructions of service personnel.
- When it is busy on the road, the ships are collected and the waiting time increases slightly.
- If the lights are green and red, it is the sign that the bridge will open soon. This is the time to sail in the direction of the bridge.
- When the bridge opens, proceed smoothly and do not make road traffic wait unnecessarily.
- Give any oncoming traffic through the bridge enough space.
- After the bridge, immediately choose starboard shore again.
- Can you pass under a closed bridge? Then pass under the correct bridge section and always pay close attention to oncoming traffic, especially commercial shipping.

# **Remotely operated bridges**

A bridge operator is increasingly operating the bridges remotely, with the help of cameras. It helps the bridge operator to capture the ship within the range of the cameras. Make sure you can see the camera clearly from your berth. This allows the bridge operator to see that there are ships that want to pass the bridge. Registration remains necessary and can usually be done via the VHF radio or sports button.

# Passing movable bridges

Are you approaching a movable bridge? Then adjust the speed and do not overtake other ships, unless the bridge operator indicates otherwise. Mooring at the waiting area is only allowed to wait for bridge operation. It is not a place to spend the night. With the sound signal 'long-short-long – • –' you can ask for bridge control.


In the case of movable bridges, lights indicate the status and the priority rules that apply. The following are the most common lights at bridges.

# Bridges in operation (being operated)

Red lights always indicate that passage is prohibited, unless there are extra yellow or green lights on. Then sailing on is allowed. During the opening and closing of a bridge, the yellow lights can remain on and the following applies: passage is allowed for ships of limited height, when one yellow light is on, passage from the other side is also possible. At two yellow lights, passage from the other side is not allowed.

# Bridges out of operation (not operated)

Double red lights always indicate that the bridge is not operated and that passage is prohibited, unless additional yellow or green lights are on. Then you can go through.













# What to do at locks?

- Don't float around in front of the lock. Moor at the waiting jetty.
- Even on a small ship you can report to the lock master via the VHF and get instructions for locking. There is usually a report button on waiting jetties for those who do not have a VHF radio on board.
- Avoid annoying waves.
- Join at the back or alongside waiting ships and wait your turn.
- Always follow the instructions of the lock master.
- Hang enough fenders on both sides of your ship.
- Wait for a red light. Only enter a lock if it is allowed.
- When the lights are green and red, this is the sign that the lock will open soon. Make sure you are ready to enter the lock.
- Give space to the shipping that leaves the chamber.
- Ships must enter the lock in order of arrival. At locks where commercial and recreational shipping meet, commercial shipping enters the lock first, unless the lock master indicates otherwise. This is done for the sake of safety and smoothness. The following applies to recreational shipping: wait until commercial shipping has tied the ropes and screws out before entering.
- Sail as far forward as possible in the lock and connect well. Keep a sufficient distance from commercial shipping, the lock gate and, where necessary, to the water inlet.
- Secure your ship with enough mooring lines. Make sure they don't get stuck. Celebrate them in time when the water sinks and tighten them in time when the water rises.
- Mooring lines fastned? Screws out!
- Listen to your VHF radio while passing through a lock, but do not use it unnecessarily.

# Lock together

Passing through locks requires extra attention. Both professional and recreational skippers have to manoeuvre within a limited space at a lock. This requires attentiveness and communication, with each other and with the lock masters. Be considerate of each other and ensure that the lock passage runs smoothly and safely. Jumping the queue is of course out of the question, wait for your turn. Stick to the rules.

#### Smooth and safe through bridge and lock?

Know the rules and be considerate of other waterway users.

# Protecting from fresh to salt

Are you moving from fresh to salt water? Always secure the back of your ship first. The current in the lock can cause your ship to end up in the lock transversely or backwards. The forces of the water on the ship are much greater than those of the wind, especially in the shelter of the lock.

# Stewards: helping hand

Good weather causes increasing crowds on the waterways. In the summer period, Rijkswaterstaat therefore deploys stewards at busy locks. Stewards offer water sports enthusiasts a helping hand with mooring and thus ensure a smoother flow of shipping. In the province of Groningen at the Robbengat lock in Lauwersoog (waterway 31).

# Passage of locks

The request to operate a lock is the same signal as that for a bridge: -.-

The meaning of the lights at locks is largely similar to that of bridges.

# Stop line

The lock usually has a marking (stop line) within which you can moor safely. Stay within these markers.



This sign means: Obligation for the sign to stop under certain circumstances.

# **Height Displays**

Sometimes yellow-black height scales or height signs indicate the available clearance (H) of bridges or other spans. The numeral indication is in meters.



# **Height scale**

The height scale is placed on the starboard side or on both sides of the passage opening of a bridge. A height scale is divided into blocks of 1 meter; Depending on the local situation, the indication of the height scale is sometimes in half meters and decimeters.

# Height sign

On some waterways, the available clearance height (H) is indicated by a height sign on the span.

# **Discharge ban**

Throughout the province, it is forbidden to discharge the contents of the toilets of recreational boats. The locations of pumping stations for dirty water are listed on https://waterrecreatienederland.nl/viewer-vuilwater-innamepunt/.

# Registration of video images and VHF radio traffic

Data is recorded at the control stations of the province of Groningen where bridges and locks are operated remotely. The video images of the operation and the VHF radio traffic are recorded. This data can be used after emergencies and incidents. For example, after a collision with a bridge, or in the event of a complaint about the operation.

# **Fishing nets**

Professional fishermen are also active on the inland waterways in our province. The fishermen set out traps and trap sticks in some canals, maars, ditches and on the lakes. These fish traps are placed with sticks from the bank to the middle. When passing such a trap, make sure that you sail through the widest part of the canal. On the lakes, you can recognize the fish traps by the sticks with a flag attached to them.

In a number of places you may encounter a so-called 'closing net'. This net is placed across the width of the canal and closes the canal at night. Skippers are warned with red lights. Passing can be done by giving a sound signal to the fisherman, who then lowers the net.

The fishing nets are placed in the Reitdiep, Hunsingokanaal, Termunterzijldiep, Lauwersmeer near the Robbengat lock, Drentse Diep near the Zuidlaardermeer, Aduarderdiep near Aduarderzijl, Winsumerdiep near Winsum towards Onderdendam, the Kommerzijlsterriet near Electra and in the Lauwers just before the Frisian lock.
